
Chart of the Ages From Paradise Lost to Paradise Restored

of the unjustified plane in Chart of the Ages. The Court enclosure parallels the justified or Perfect Human plane. The "Holy" represents the condition of consecrated Christians, **Begotten of the Spirit**. The **Most** Holy, beyond the second veil, represents the Perfect Spiritual condition when "we shall be like Him." The glory plane is still further along the grand climax of hope — "Glory, Honor and Immortality."
